SMEC Wins Solid Waste Management Pilot Scheme Study in Nigeria

17 February 2017

SMEC has won a contract with the Kaduna State Water Board to carry out an African Development Bank-funded Solid Waste Management Study in Zaria, Nigeria.

The Kaduna State Water Board is trialling a Pilot Scheme to determine the viability of a broader Solid Waste Management program in the area.

SMEC has been engaged to ensure efficient design and management of solid waste management facilities, and appropriate processing and sanitary disposal of solid waste within the Pilot Scheme area.

SMEC's scope of work includes: analysis of existing waste management services in the region; strategic framework design; capacity building services; and community and stakeholder engagement.

The objective of the Pilot Scheme is to ensure 100% success rate of Solid Waste Management processes prior to an expanded program rollout across Zaria.
